Minimum Energy Performance Standards (MEPS) and codes

Support the manufacturing, distribution and use of high MEPS appliances, alongside the implementation of enhanced energy codes in buildings and operations.

Energy management and data transparency

Encourage regular energy reviews and robust energy management plans that provide transparent energy data to help determine areas of energy loss and gains.

Circularity and renovation

Promote passive techniques as well as circularity and renovations in buildings, appliances and operations.

Financing

Increase investment in energy efficiency and support innovative financing methods, to reach the [USD 1.5 trillion needed per year](#) to meet the COP28 pledge and [prevent investment flatlining](#).

Collaboration and leadership

Keep energy efficiency high on the global agenda within Nationally Determined Contribution (NDCs) and Global Stocktake process, in addition to encouraging collaboration across different levels of private and public sectors to drive faster action.
