#### **Campaign Overview**

**Clean, healthy, smart road transport – for all.** Transport accounts for around a quarter of global energy-related CO2 emissions.<sup>1</sup> At the same time, light-duty electric vehicle (EV) sales now represent 25% of the global market, and sales of medium and heavy-duty vehicles (MHDVs) continue to grow at pace, exceeding 90,000 worldwide in 2024.<sup>2</sup>

**Businesses play a major role in driving the uptake of EVs and the roll-out of EV charging infrastructure.**

The electrification of road transport across all vehicle segments – cars, vans, trucks – will cut millions of tonnes of CO2 every year, curbing air pollution at the same time. It's one of the most effective ways for any company or country to drive climate action, fast.

We launched [EV100](#) as a global initiative at Climate Week NYC in September 2017, and today it is a vibrant global network of forward-thinking companies all dedicated to fully electrifying their fleets.

We provide a platform for companies to:

- Engage in dialogue with governments and other stakeholders to collaboratively address barriers to EV adoption.

**The commitment:** EV100 catalyses ambitious corporate leadership on ZEV uptake and charging infrastructure roll-out. Companies joining make a public commitment to accelerate global EV uptake and install charging infrastructure according to a tiered deadline structure based on existing and predicted EV uptake. - **Impact Reporting** Regular reporting through the EV100 Progress and Insights Report delivers accountability, credibility and transparency. It helps us demonstrate progress towards transport decarbonisation and the impact of our network. The total number of EVs deployed by our network has surpassed 700,000 across more than 75 countries.

## Membership fees

**EV100 membership fees for 2025/26 are \$6,750; membership year starts on your joining date.** Fees are reviewed every Autumn based on inflation. We will let members know of any changes at least four months in advance.

As part of the joining process, the EV100 team will first send a Joining Form to collect your commitment and relevant details, followed by a Membership Agreement. Once complete, we will send the member's first annual invoice directly to your delegated Finance contact.
