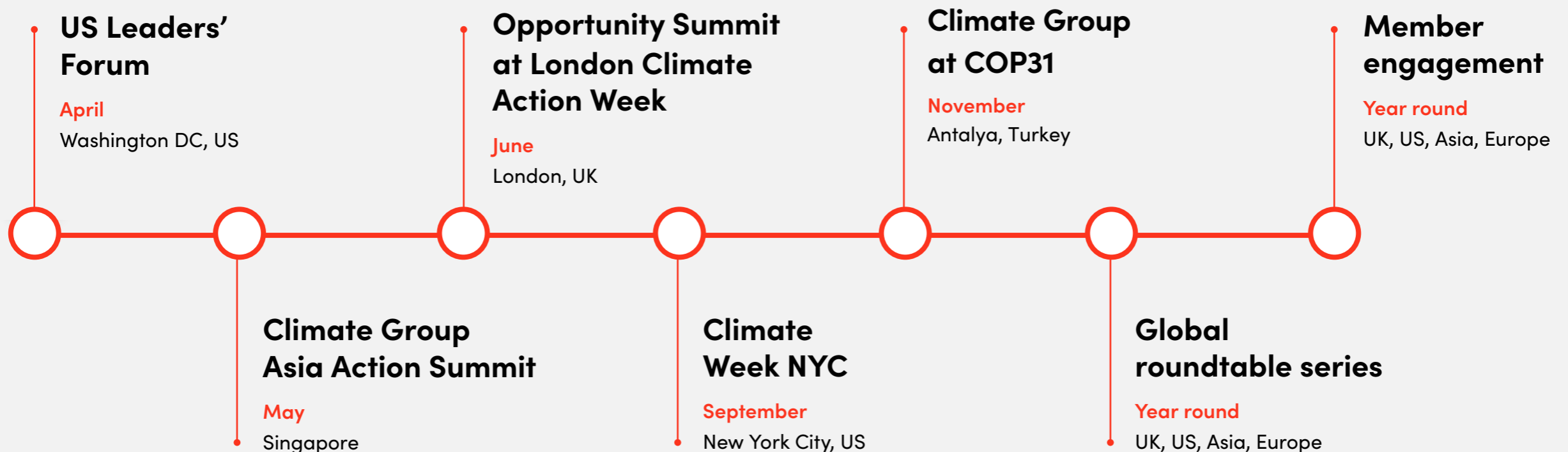

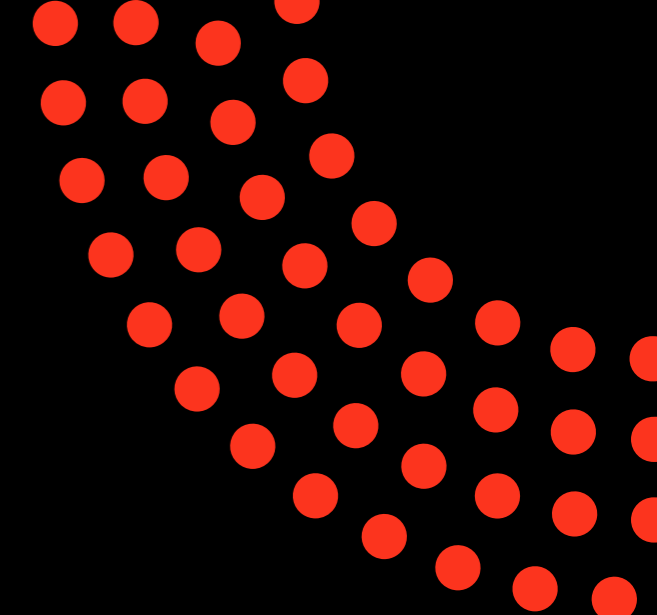

Our impact

Climate Group leads with impact across all the work we do. Here's a sample of some of our most recent impacts...

1. We drive credible and ambitious climate commitments

Through the Increasing Ambition project, we successfully persuaded 20 prospective members of RE100, operating in less mature renewable energy markets, to commit to more ambitious target dates of 2040 or earlier for achieving 100% renewable electricity – averting an estimated 49TWh of fossil fuel powered electricity, equivalent to a month of electricity use in the UK.

2. We accelerate action and implementation

The Under2 Coalition Future Fund supported direct subnational action on the ground through three projects including the first air quality monitoring network in Tucumán, Argentina and digital community empowerment in Pernambuco, Brazil.

3. We influence policy in critical geographies

After years of advocating with the UK Electric Fleet Coalition, the UK government adopted a ZEV Mandate, effective as of January 2024. With this mandate, the UK has an ambitious regulatory framework which will help accelerate the uptake of EVs in the country.

4. We promote a narrative of unstoppable momentum on climate action

We delivered Climate Week NYC, the largest, global, climate moment of 2025, with 5,573 people from 85 countries attending our core events with more C-suites and government officials than ever before. Over 100 journalists joined us, generating some 30 billion media views, and 1 billion impressions of the hashtag #ClimateWeekNYC.
